Arc Cobb was formed in 1956 and served both Cobb and surrounding counties, providing services for people with disabilities- ranging from mild to severe mental retardation- as well as other types of developmental disabilities. In addition to basic family services, Arc Cobb began building homes for people with disabilities in partnership with HUD, and with the assistance of private and corporate donations. In 2007, Arc Cobb changed its name to **Right in the Community**. The name changed but the mission is the same.

This Play All Day Event is a great way of raising funds for these special homes. I have seen it first hand and believe in what RitC is doing. I am asking you to believe in it and to commit to playing golf with us and soliciting contributions from your friends, family, church, co-workers, and business contacts. It's fun. It's challenging.
